Tone of the Week: 8 • Great Doxology: Tone 1

DIVINE LITURGY OF ST. BASIL THE GREAT

A: First Antiphon: Through the intercessions of the Theotokos, O Savior, save us.

B: Second Antiphon: Save us, O Son of God, Who art risen from the dead; who sing to Thee. Alleluia.

Glory... Both now... O, only begotten Son and Word of God...

C: Third Antiphon: Troparion of the resurrection – see below

D: Entrance Hymn: Usual Sunday: "Come let us worship..."

E: Troparia

Troparion of the Resurrection – Tone 8 (pg. 102 in *The Divine Liturgy for Clergy and Laity*): From the heights Thou didst descend, O compassionate One, and Thou didst submit to the three-day burial, that Thou might deliver us from passion; Thou art our life and our Resurrection, O Lord, glory to Thee.

Troparion for St. John Climacus – Tone 8: The barren wilderness thou didst make fertile with the streams of thy tears; and by thy deep sighing thou hast given fruit through thy struggles a hundredfold. Accordingly, thou hast become a star for the universe, sparkling with miracles. Therefore, O righteous Father John Climacus, intercede with Christ God to save our souls.

Troparion of All Saints of North America – Tone 1

F: Kontakion for Lent – Tone 8: To thee, the Champion Leader, do I offer thanks of victory, O Theotokos, thou who hast delivered me from terror; but as thou that hast that power invincible, O Theotokos, thou alone can set me free: from all forms of danger free me and deliver me, that I may cry unto thee: Hail, O Bride without Bridegroom.
