DIVINE LITURGY OF ST. JOHN CHRYSOSTOM

A: First Antiphon: Through the intercessions of the Theotokos, O Savior, save us.

B: Second Antiphon: Save us, O Son of God, who art risen from the dead, who sing to thee. Alleluia.

C: Third Antiphon: chant the Troparion of the Resurrection in Tone 8.

D: Entrance Hymn: Save us, O Son of God, who art risen from the dead, who sing to Thee. Alleluia.

E: Troparia

Troparion of the Resurrection – Tone 3 (pg. 95 in *The Divine Liturgy for Clergy and Laity*): Let the heavens rejoice and the earth be glad, for the Lord hath done a mighty act with His own arm. He hath trampled down death by death, and become the first-born from the dead. He hath delivered us from the depths of Hades, granting the world the Great Mercy.

Troparion of St. Joseph of Damascus – Tone 5: Come, ye faithful, let us honor the martyr of Christ, a priest of the Church of Antioch; who by the word of the Word, and by his blood and the blood of his companions, baptized the land of Syria, its Church and its people. Being immersed in the light of the Gospel from his youth, he worked and taught and defended the Church of Christ and her flock. O Father Joseph of Damascus, be for us an example, defending us and interceding for us fervently before the Savior.

Troparion of All Saints of North America – Tone 1

F: Kontakion for Ordinary Sundays – Tone 2: O undisputed intercessor of Christians, the Mediatrix who is unrejected by the Creator; turn not away from the voice of our petitions, although we be sinners. Come to us, in time, with aid as we cry unto thee in faith, for thou art good. Hasten to us with intercessions, O Theotokos, who didst ever intercede for those that honor thee.

G: Trisagion: usual Sunday
