Tone of the Week: 3 • Great Doxology: Tone 1

DIVINE LITURGY OF ST. JOHN CHRYSOSTOM

A: First Antiphon: Through the intercessions of the Theotokos, O Savior, save us.

B: Second Antiphon: Save us, O Son of God, Who art risen from the dead; who sing to Thee. Alleluia.

C: Third Antiphon: chant the Troparion of the Resurrection in Tone 3.

D: Entrance Hymn: Come, let us worship, and fall down before Christ. Save us, O Son of God, who art risen from the dead, who sing to Thee. Alleluia.

E: Troparia

Troparion of the Resurrection – Tone 3 (pg. 95 in *The Divine Liturgy for Clergy and Laity*): Let the heavens rejoice and the earth be glad, for the Lord hath done a mighty act with His own arm. He hath trampled down death by death and become the first-born from the dead. He hath delivered us from the depths of Hades, granting the world the Great Mercy.

Troparion of St. Babylas of Antioch – Tone 4: By choosing the Apostles' way of life, thou hast succeeded to their throne. Inspired by God, thou didst find the way to divine contemplation through the practice of virtue. After teaching the Word of Truth without error, thou didst defend the Faith to the very shedding of thy blood, O Hieromartyr Babylas. Entreat the Lord our God to save our souls.

Troparion of All Saints of North America – Tone 1

F: Kontakion for the Nativity of the Theotokos – Tone 4: By thy holy nativity, O pure one, Joachim and Anna were delivered from the reproach of barrenness; and Adam and Eve were delivered from the corruption of death; thy people do celebrate it, having been saved from the stain of iniquity, crying unto thee: The barren doth give birth to the Theotokos, who nourisheth our life.

G: Trisagion: usual Sunday

- *Gospel:* St. Matthew 19:16-26
