TRANSFER OF THE ENTRANCE OF THE THEOTOKOS

**Tone of the Week: 6 • Great Doxology: Tone 2**

**DIVINE LITURGY OF ST. JOHN CHRYSOSTOM**

**A: First Antiphon:** Great is the Lord and greatly to be praised: in the city of our God and in His holy mountain. Glorious things are spoken of thee, O city of God.

**Refrain:** Through the intercessions of the Theotokos, O Savior, save us.

God is known in her palaces for a refuge. As we have heard, so have we seen in the city of the Lord of hosts, in the city of our God. (**Refrain**)

Glory... Both now... (**Refrain**)

**B: Second Antiphon:** The Most High hath sanctified His tabernacle. Holiness and majesty are in His sanctuary.

**Refrain:** Save us, O Son of God, Who art risen from the dead; who sing to Thee. Alleluia.

This is the gate of the Lord, the righteous shall enter in thereat. (**Refrain**)

Holy is Thy temple, and wonderful in righteousness. (**Refrain**)

Glory... Both now... O, only begotten Son and Word of God...

**C: Third Antiphon:** Even the rich among the people shall entreat thy favor. The King's daughter is all glorious within: her clothing is of wrought gold. Virgins shall be brought to the King after her: her companions shall be brought unto Thee.

- *Then chant the Troparion of the Entrance of the Theotokos (see below).*

**D: Entrance Hymn:** Come, let us worship, and fall down before Christ. Save us, O Son of God, who art risen from the dead, who sing to Thee. Alleluia.

**E: Troparia**

**Troparion of the Resurrection – Tone 6** (pg. 99 in *The Divine Liturgy for Clergy and Laity*): When Mary stood at Thy grave, looking for Thy sacred body, angelic powers shone above Thy revered tomb; and the soldiers who were to keep guard became as dead men. Thou led Hades captive and wast not tempted thereby. Thou didst meet the Virgin and didst give life to the world, O Thou, Who art risen from the dead, O Lord, glory to Thee.

**Troparion of the Entrance of the Theotokos into the Temple – Tone 4:** Today the Virgin is the foreshadowing of the pleasure of God, and the beginning of the preaching of the salvation of mankind. Thou hast appeared in the Temple of God openly and hast gone before, preaching Christ to all. Let us shout with one thrilling voice, saying, Rejoice, O thou who art the fulfillment of the Creator's dispensation.

**Troparion of All Saints of North America – Tone 1 – NOT sung today**

**F: Kontakion of the Entrance of the Theotokos – Tone 4:** The sacred treasury of God’s holy glory, the greatly precious bridal chamber and Virgin, the Savior’s most pure temple, free of stain and undefiled, into the House of the Lord on this day is brought forward and bringeth with herself the grace of the Most Divine Spirit; her do God’s Angels hymn with songs of praise, for she is truly the heavenly tabernacle.

**G: Trisagion:** usual Sunday

**H: Liturgy of the Word:**

- *Epistle:* Hebrews 9:1– 7
- *Gospel:* Luke 10:38-42; 11:27-28
