Tone of the Week: 7 • Great Doxology: Tone 6

DIVINE LITURGY OF ST. JOHN CHRYSOSTOM

A: First Antiphon: Through the intercessions of the Theotokos, O Savior, save us.

B: Second Antiphon: Save us, O Son of God, Who art risen from the dead; who sing to Thee. Alleluia.

C: Third Antiphon: *During the Little Entrance, chant the Troparion of the Resurrection. Then, the following:*

D: Entrance Hymn: Save us, O Son of God, Who art risen from the dead; who sing to Thee. Alleluia.

E: Troparia

Troparion of the Resurrection – Tone 7 (pg. 101 in *The Divine Liturgy for Clergy and Laity*): Thou didst shatter death by Thy Cross, Thou didst open paradise to the thief; Thou didst turn the sadness of the ointment-bearing women into joy. And didst bid Thine Apostles proclaim a warning, that Thou hast risen O Christ, granting to the world the Great Mercy.

Troparion of St. Timothy the Apostle: – Tone 4: Since thou hadst been instructed in uprightness thoroughly and wast vigilant in all things, thou wast clothed with a good conscience as befitteth one holy. Thou didst draw from the Chosen Vessel ineffable mysteries; and having kept the Faith, thou didst finish the course, O Hieromartyr and Apostle Timothy. Intercede with Christ God that our souls may be saved.

Troparion of St. Anastasios the Persian: – Tone 4: Thy Martyr, O Lord, in his courageous contest for Thee received as the prize the crowns of incorruption and life from Thee, our immortal God. For since he possessed Thy strength, he cast down the tyrants and wholly destroyed the demons' strengthless presumption. O Christ God, by his prayers, save our souls since Thou art merciful.

Troparion of All Saints of North America – Tone 1

F: Kontakion for the Presentation of Christ – Tone 1: Thou, O Christ God, Who by Thy Birth, didst sanctify the Virgin's womb and, as is meet, didst bless Simeon's arms, and didst also come to save us; preserve Thy fold in wars, and confirm them whom Thou didst love, for Thou alone art the Lover of mankind.

G: Trisagion: Usual Sunday.

- *Gospel:* Luke 19:1-10 "Zacchaeus Sunday"
