Tone of the Week: 6 • Great Doxology: Tone 6

DIVINE LITURGY OF ST. BASIL THE GREAT

A: First Antiphon: Through the intercessions of the Theotokos, O Savior, save us.

B: Second Antiphon: Save us, O Son of God, Who art risen from the dead; who sing to Thee. Alleluia.

C: Third Antiphon: *chant the Apolytikion of the Resurrection.*

D: Entrance Hymn: Save us, O Son of God, Who art risen from the dead, who sing to Thee. Alleluia.

E: Troparia

Troparion of the Resurrection – Tone 6 (pg. 99 in *The Divine Liturgy for Clergy and Laity*): When Mary stood at Thy grave, looking for Thy sacred body, angelic powers shone above Thy revered tomb; and the soldiers who were to keep guard became as dead men. Thou led Hades captive and wast not tempted thereby. Thou didst meet the Virgin and didst give life to the world, O Thou, Who art risen from the dead, O Lord, glory to Thee.

Troparion for St. Gregory Palamas – Tone 8: O Star of Orthodoxy, support of the Church and its teacher, O comeliness of ascetics, and incontestable champion of those who speak in theology, Gregory the wonder-worker, the pride of Thessalonica and preacher of grace, implore thou constantly for the salvation of our souls.
